

On 04/18/2023, the remains of an unknown female were discovered partially submerged in a creek underneath a bridge on Highway 165 near milepost 10 within the Cibola National Forest in Placitas, NM. The victim appeared to be American Indian, between 15 – 35 years old, 5'2", and weighed approximately 95 pounds. The victim was wearing a sports-bra, black shorts, and dark blue shirt with red stars. The victim's cause of death is undetermined.
