The St. Louis County Police Department has issued an Endangered Person Advisory for a missing person that occurred at Destrehan Road in the Columbia Bottom Conservation Area at 5:30 PM on August 20, 2025.

## Missing Is:

Steven H Reed a black, male, age 41

The endangered missing person:

Steven H Reed is a black male, age 41. He is 5 feet 6 inches tall and weighs approximately 155 pounds. He has black hair, brown eyes, a dark complexion, and has tattoos on his left arm. He was last seen wearing a white T-shirt and olive-colored shorts.

Brief circumstances regarding the Endangered Missing Person:

Steven Reed's family has not seen or heard from him since August 18, 2025. On the evening of August 20, 2025, his vehicle was found abandoned in the Columbia Bottom Conservation Area off Destrehan Road. Officers have searched the area and have been unable to locate Mr. Reed, who may be suicidal.
